BYLAW NO. 605

A bylaw to provide for the Removal of snow and ice from sidewalks

Now therefore, Council of the Corporation of the Village Of Keremeos, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “Snow Clearing Bylaw No. 605, 2000”.
2. Every person who is the owner of property, or the occupier of premises, within a commercially zoned area of the Village of Keremeos shall remove and clear away snow and ice from sidewalks bordering their property or premises before the hour of 10:00 a.m. each day.
3. Every person who is the owner of property, or occupier of premises, within a residentially zoned area of the Village of Keremeos shall remove and clear away snow and ice from sidewalks bordering their property or premises before the hour of 6:00 p.m. each day.
4. If a person fails to clear snow and ice as required by Section 2 or 3 of this bylaw, the Village of Keremeos may, by its staff or contractors, remove any accumulation of snow and ice from sidewalks in the Village of Keremeos.
5. The Village of Keremeos may invoice the cost of snow and ice removed pursuant to Section 4, to the person in default.
6. If a person charged under Section 5 of this bylaw fails to pay by December 31st of the year charged, the Village of Keremeos may recover the expense by adding the charges as taxes in Arrears against the property.
7. Sidewalk Clearing By-Law No. 195, 1975, and amendment thereto, are hereby repealed.
